Before becoming a career missionary, Naomi worked in hospitals in the Columbus, OH and in the Minneapolis, MN metropolitan areas. For the past six years, she has worked at Karanda Mission Hospital, a TEAM affiliated rural health care facility in Zimbabwe. At the hospital, she treats HIV and other complex cases in the pediatric ward. She is also an instructor at the nursing school associated with Karanda Mission Hospital. In addition to these duties, she assists in a Home Based Care program, coordinating the health care and physical needs for orphans in the Karanda area. God has given Naomi a heart and love for the Zimbabwean people.
